2. What was Jesus's criticism of this church and how do they parallel some of the issues we may have? What are some practical things we could do to better glorify Jesus in these areas? (Revelation 3:15-17)
3. What was Jesus's challenge to this church and what are the challenges to us here at New Covenant Church? How could we live them out? (Revelation 3:18-19)
4. What is Jesus's counsel to this church and what is the promise made if they heed the counsel? How does this encourage you to heed the counsel of Jesus and His Word? (Revelation 3:20-22)
