Read Revelation 5:1-14

1. What does the overall picture of 5:1-7 reveal about who controls all the events on earth? How does Jesus portrayed as all-seeing and all-knowing (the horns and eyes of 5:6) comfort and motivate you in daily life?
2. What do the four groups praise Christ for in 5:8-14? How could you imitate these four groups on a practical level?
3. What privileges and power do we possess as "priests to serve our God" (5:9-10)? Consider your regular contributions to the advancement of God's kingdom. How are you doing in the areas of time, treasures, and talents? (Be specific here.)
4. Compare 5:11-14 with your personal experiences of worship during the past month. What differences are there? What similarities are there? What can you change about your worship that would be consistent with this passage?
5. In 5:12 the angels use seven expressions to indicate the wonder of the Lamb. Can you name and define these seven expressions? Which is the most meaningful to you and why?
