*Daniel 2:1-30*

## **The Big Idea:**

God puts us in impossible situations so that He alone gets the \_\_\_\_\_  
from an outcome that only He could \_\_\_\_\_. (Daniel 2:1-30)

## **Life Lessons from Daniel 2**

Life Lesson #1: God often allows us to face \_\_\_\_\_

Life Lesson #2: Daniel made his impossible situation known to his \_\_\_\_\_.

## **Living Like Daniel In a Babylonian World:**

1. Sleep well knowing that God never sleeps as He sovereignly rules over all of  
\_\_\_\_\_. (Psalm 127:2)

2. Sleep well knowing that although you don't know what the \_\_\_\_\_  
holds, you know who holds the \_\_\_\_\_. (Daniel 2:22)

3. Sleep well knowing that since the \_\_\_\_\_ world is in God's hands,  
\_\_\_\_\_ world is in God's hands. (Isaiah 40:12)

If God can rule over all of creation, use evil kings and kingdoms for His purposes,  
and overcome sin and death, He can certainly rule over and use our lives for His  
glory and our good. Like Daniel, let's trust Him to do so!

4. What is there to be learned from Daniel's prayer in verses 20-23, especially given the circumstance he was in?

5. What does Daniel's response reveal about his character? What do your responses to life situations reveal about your character?
