1. It has great <u>purpose</u>. (Acts 1:8)

- Their purpose was to be a witness as to who Christ was and what He has done.
- Everything we do must be geared around this one purpose and devoid of any human agenda!

2. It has great power. (Acts 2:1-4)

3. It has great preaching. (Acts 2:14-41)

What made it great?:

- ♦ 2. It convicted sinners.

- → 4. It involved a personal commitment.
- ♦ 5. It lead people to Jesus.

We are all called to preach/proclaim the Gospel and we are commanded to do it in such a way that Jesus is exalted, sinners are convicted, God's grace is displayed, people are invited to make a personal commitment, and it leads people to Jesus!

4. It has great people. (Acts 2:42-47)

→ They had people willing to give up everything for Jesus!

5. It has great <u>promises</u>. (Acts 13:32-39)

→ They had the promise of Jesus, His Holy Spirit, heaven, and many other promises. So do we!

6. It has great <u>leaders</u>. (Acts 14:19-23)

◆ They had leaders committed to the advancement of the Gospel regardless of personal cost that then established other leaders willing to do the same.
